Remember the people who are already living in slavery in Canada and around the world: those who have been recruited, bought, and sold for the purpose of exploitation.

Pray for:

- Safety and miracles
- Escape and freedom
- Restoration, hope and peace
- Access to adequate services (health care, shelter, legal services, counselling, retraining/education)
