


Week 12

Day 1



Jehovah Rocks:

Everyday as I wake, walk around, eat and live, I know that You love me! And so everyday I will try to live exactly as You would want me to live. (Psalm 26:3)

See It:

'So, you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when He adopted you as His own children. Now we call Him, "Abba, Father." For His Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's children. And since we are His children, we are His heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share His glory, we must also share His suffering.' (Romans 8:15-17)

On It:

There is a massive difference between being a slave and being a son or daughter. A slave is 'owned'; a son or daughter belongs and, even more than that, is an heir. A slave lives in fear; a son or daughter enjoys a security blanket of love. A slave has to do what the master commands; the spiritual son or daughter, by the Holy Spirit, cries, "Abba, Father." 'Abba' is a Bible word that is similar to 'daddy' or 'papa'. So, this is a warm, loving, close relationship that the Holy Spirit allows us to have with God our Father. And while the slave inevitably suffers, we as children of our Father God share in Jesus' sufferings and then, in His glory. Hallelujah.

Live It:

The Salvation Army is committed to reaching the whole world with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Our mission is to win the world for Jesus.

Pray for the list of five names you just wrote every morning before you get up, and every night just before you go to sleep.


Eat It: (Memorize this verse this week)

Day 2



Jehovah Rocks:

I love being in Your presence and I love being able to be close to You. I love to worship You. (Psalm 26:8)

See It:

'Jesus replied, "If anyone loves Me, he will obey My teaching. My Father will love him, and We will come to Him and make our home with him.'" (John 14:23)

On It:

It's just natural, isn't it? When you love someone you want to please that person. Jesus is pretty blunt about it – if you love Him you will obey Him. The opposite is also true. If you don't obey Him, then you don't love Him. Ouch. But it is a good way to measure your love for Him. And if you love and obey Jesus, then you receive the love of God the Father. And Yahweh (the name of the Godhead) comes to set up shop in your life, to lay down roots in your life, to hang His shingle outside your door, to change His address to yours, and to make your life His home!

Live It:

World Evangelization is: Enabling every person on earth to hear the gospel in a way they can understand, and have a real opportunity to become a Christian. (definition by The Salvation Army, IHQ).

Do It:

Ask those five people you are praying for if there is anything they would like prayer for.

In It:

Holy Spirit, please fill everyone with the passion to win souls for the kingdom today!

Eat It: 1 Thessalonians 5:17

Jehovah Rocks:

Thank You for loving me God! You know when I am sad, and when I am worried and You comfort me with Your love. (Psalm 31:7)

See It:

'Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles.' (2 Corinthians 1:3-4a)

On It:

Amen! Hallelujahweh! God, our FATHER! And Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! You are the God of all comfort! You comfort us in all our troubles. Thanks for comforting me in the hard times I'm facing. And as You comfort me, I can comfort people in my family and at my corps and in school who are facing trouble these days. We pass on that comfort. Amen. The word 'comfort' means 'with strength'. God our Father brings us strength. Is there anything for which you need strength this week? Because if there is, our Father, God (assuming you are saved from sin), is here to strengthen you! Thanks, God!

Live It:

Between May 1882 and June 1883 The Salvation Army invaded seven countries. This remains the fastest rate of growth in our history. But, right now we want to challenge it with a growth rate that makes recording it in the yearbook impossible! Because as soon as they print it... we've grown even more!

Do It:

Tell your teacher you would like to recite all of the memory verses you know so far.

In It:

Day 4



Jehovah Rocks:

(Psalm 33:5)

Do It:

See It:



'I will be a Father to you, and you will be My sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty. I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be My people. Therefore, come out from them and be separate, says the Lord... I will be a Father to you, and you will be My sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty.' (2 Corinthians 6:16-18)

On It:

When I was little, my brothers used to tell me that I was adopted. It was their way of being mean so that they could get me to cry... and it usually worked! I didn't want to be adopted, I wanted to be the real daughter of my real mom. As I got older, I started to realize that when you are adopted you do become a real daughter of a real mom! Well, good news! God wants to adopt you into His family! Then you will become a real daughter or son of the real Father in Heaven! Everyone who believes in Jesus, everyone who receives Him, becomes a child of God. We get adopted into His family, and we get born again (we are specially-chosen children – adopted – and naturally-born children). So, in the book of John 1, we are to receive Him. And here in Corinthians, He receives US! But there is a little catch. We need to come out from the world (which means loving the things God loves and not the things we love) and avoid evil.

Live It:

We are committed to World Evangelization because we accept that Christ's Great Commission applies to us and we know how much salvation has transformed us, so we want to share it with others throughout the world.



In It:

Think of something that is holding you back from getting people saved. Maybe it's your nerves, or not knowing the right words. Then ask God to take that away and fill you with the power to be able to introduce people to Jesus.

Eat It: 1 Thessalonians 5:17


What makes prayer so special? It is our direct communication with God. It's just talking to God, telling Him what you're thinking, what you need, praising and thanking Him.

See It:

'Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.'
(James 1:17)

On It:

Did you ever get a present for Christmas or for your birthday? What was your favourite one? I once received Rock 'em, Sock 'em Robots and my brothers and I played it heaps. But do you know what? Every good gift, every perfect gift comes from our Heavenly Father! I'm not talking about Rock 'em Sock 'em or Hot Wheels 'Total Control Racing' (another gift from my childhood). I'm talking about gifts like health, friends, family, education (yes, school is a gift!), opportunities, and positive experiences. And I'm talking about deeper things than that – stuff like grace, mercy, forgiveness, salvation, sanctification, compassion, faith, and love. These good and perfect gifts come from our Father in Heaven! And He is amazing.

Live It:

Our activity that helps evangelize the world, no matter how small it may be, makes a contribution to world justice and peace and it helps prepare for the future coming of Jesus. (Mark 13:10 - The Salvation Army IHQ)

Do It:

Tell your teachers how much you appreciate all that they do for you and your class.

In It:

God says that He will be able to do even more than we could ask or imagine! Imagine something good for your life. Something that would honour God. Take your time, and then write down all the things that came to you.

 1 Thessalonians 5:17



Jehovah Rocks:

Yahweh, I put all of my hope in You. Fill me and surround me with Your love. (Psalm 33:22)

See It:

'Again, I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by My Father in heaven.' (Matthew 18:19)

On It:

Do you have lots of silly fights in your house with your brothers or sisters? I did! They were usually over a toy or a TV show, but my mom's solution to whatever problem we had was to take it away from the both of us. If we fought over a toy, neither would play and if we argued over who was given more chips on their plate, they were all taken away and we received none! It was hard, but it taught me a great lesson, and it is a lesson for today from Matthew. You see God is a fair Father, and He wants His children to get along nicely. Why? Because when we disagree, bad things happen and we end up sad, and your Father would prefer you to be happy and full of life. If we argue with our fellow brothers and sisters, God may take away our gifts all together so that we learn to get along. But, the flip side of that is great! When we get along and we work together to bring about something good for others, God will be like any other parent. He will smile and be joyful that His children are playing well, and He will bless you both! So get together with your friends and think of a way to help others and then ask God to help you. Live It:

Do It:

In It:

Read It:

Jehovah Rocks:

Your love is so big and high and wide and strong and it will never fail me! You are so faithful it is immeasurable. (Psalm 36:5)

See It:

'Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?' (Matthew 6:26)

On It:

Have you ever watched a bird working behind the counter at McDonalds? Ever seen an ant cleaning hotel rooms? No? Me either, and yet they always seem to have food to eat and a tree to live in and a few birds to chase around the sky or a trail of honey to find. Well, right back in Genesis we heard about God creating the animals and plants. You see God had a plan that would make it totally possible to live on earth. He created something and wanted to make sure it could last. Why? Because He loves the earth He created and wanted to make sure that everyone who lived on earth could survive. Now the most valuable creation according to God was us! And He provides everything we could ever need so that we could survive. He loves us more than all the animals combined and He is not going to leave us on our own to die! He is a good Father who provides all the things His children need, and more. In It:
