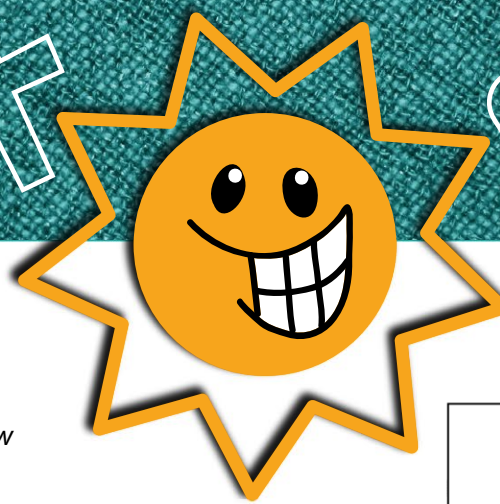


Week 3

Day 1



Jehovah Rocks:

I have decided that You are my God and I will not change my mind. I will not be afraid to tell everyone how wonderful I think You are. (Psalm 26:12)

See It:

'The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep."' (John 10:10-11)

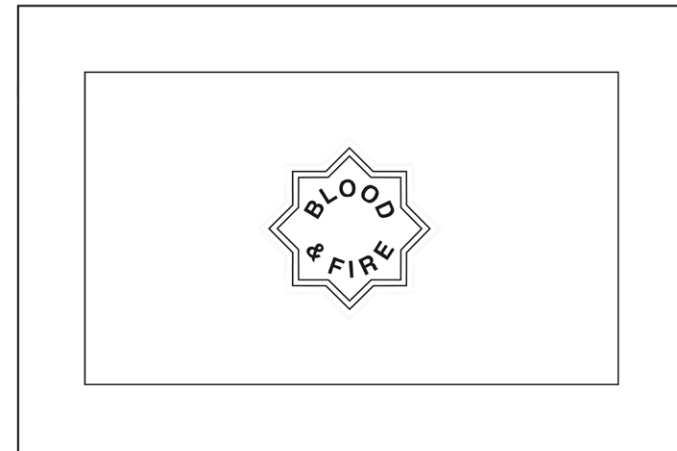
On It:

Do you know who the thief is? He's the devil, satan. And he is out to destroy you. But don't worry. He is a pipsqueak compared to our Jesus, who came to 'destroy the works of the devil'. What the devil wants to steal from you, Jesus wants to provide. Jesus Christ, the generous God, wants each of us to have an overflowing, full, rich, meaningful, happy, good, important, fun, challenging, super, tops, awesome, amazing, dazzling, tremendous life! Sounds good to me!

Live It:

You probably already know this, but The Salvation Army has a flag! And it is the same flag all over the world. It has three colours, not by chance, but because the flag itself represents the three persons of God, or in other words, the Trinity! Now that's clever!

Can you add colour to The Salvation Army flag?
Remember it's yellow, red and blue.



Do It:

Tell your family members that you are adding them to your daily prayer list (and then do it).

In It:

Thank You so much Jesus, that You have come to give me life! I am free and alive because of You! Thank You, Jesus!

Eat It:

(Memorize this verse this week)

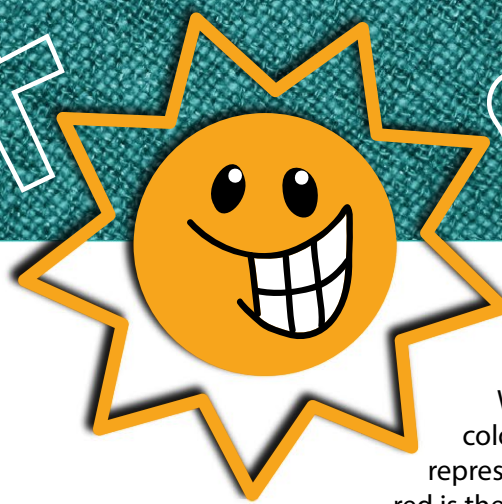

Day 2



Jehovah Rocks:

I love You, Yahweh, and am so thankful that You look after me and comfort me whenever I am feeling sad or lonely. (Psalm 28:6)

See It:

'We have been made right with God because of our faith. Now we have peace with Him because of our Lord Jesus Christ. Through faith in Jesus we have been given God's grace. In that grace we stand strong. We are full of joy and happiness because we know we are going to share in God's glory. And that's not all. We are full of joy even when we suffer! We know that even though we are suffering, He gives us the strength to go on. The strength to go on gives us character. Character produces hope. And hope will never let us down. God has poured his love into our hearts. He did it through the Holy Spirit, whom He has given to us.' (Romans 5:1-5)

On It:

Is your life really busy? Is it stressful? Sad? Lonely? Do you sometimes feel an emptiness deep down inside? It sort of feels like when you are really hungry, and your stomach calls out to you 'give me food!' You are doing everyday stuff like eating, sleeping, school and play, but you just feel like you are missing something and it needs to be filled. Well, what you might be missing is peace! We're talking about peace with God. When you have peace with God, no matter how tough, hard or busy life gets, you just know it is going to be okay because you know that God is in control. It's a great feeling. How do get it? Through our Lord Jesus Christ! That's easy because you know Him. All you have to do is ask Jesus to fill you with His peace, and then just wait for Him to do His thing.

Live It:

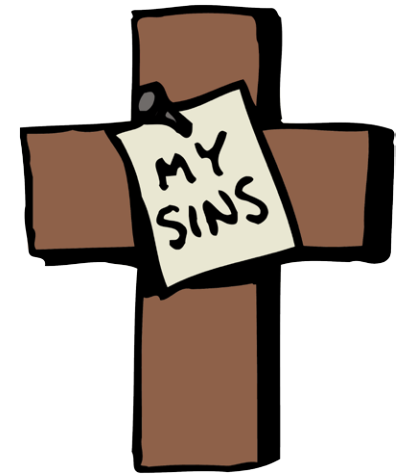
We are talking about the flag, and the three different colours in the flag. One part of the flag is red, which represents God the Son. You can remember this easily because red is the colour of blood, and the red reminds us of the forgiveness that comes from the blood of Jesus.

Do It:

Take your Bible to school.

In It:

Thank You, Jesus that You died on the cross for my sins!



Eat It:

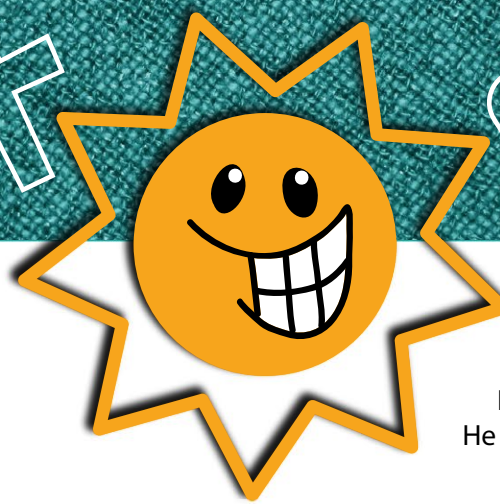

Read It:

Day 3



Jehovah Rocks:

You are so incredible and You always show me your amazing love that will never, ever run out. Even when I feel like the whole world is falling apart I still feel safe because I know that You love me. (Psalm 31:21)

See It:

'Everyone has sinned. No one measures up to God's glory.' (Romans 3:23)

On It:

All of us have sinned - your best teacher, the principal, even your Sunday School teacher! None of us have lived up to God's glory or His hopes of us to reflect His glory in our lives to the world. No one is as good as God made us to be. Think about it... He is God, the creator of the universe, and we are humans who do all sorts of nasty and silly things. Wait - does that mean we're all failures? Might that make us feel bad? Good. That's the idea. But do hang in for the rest of the week, because good news is coming!

Live It:

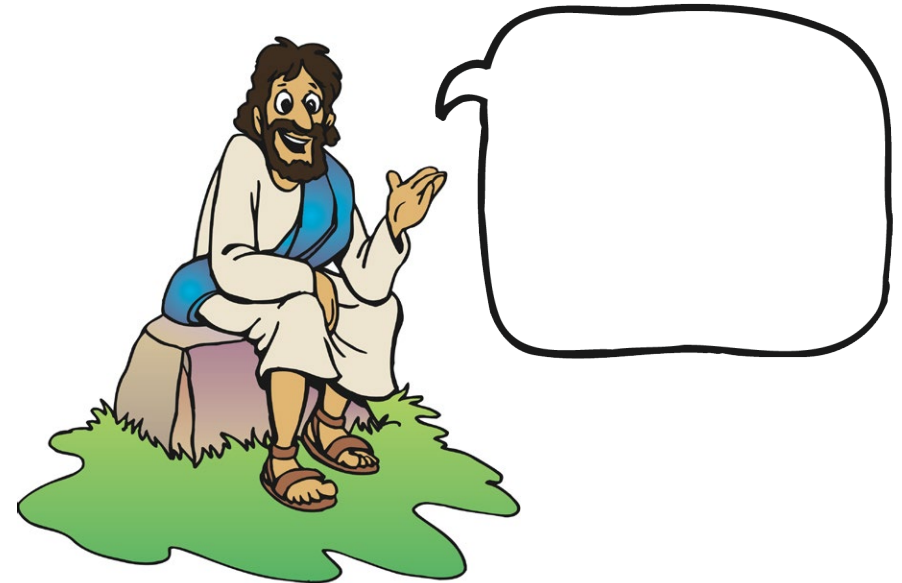
The next colour in the flag is blue, which represents God the Father. Think of a perfect blue sky over a big blue ocean. It is clean, perfect, and pure and reminds us of the clean, perfect, and pure God the Father.

Do It:

Think of something that you love about your mother or father, then go and tell them.

In It:

Imagine Jesus was sitting right in front of you. What would He say to you? (ask!)



Eat It: (Memorize the verse)

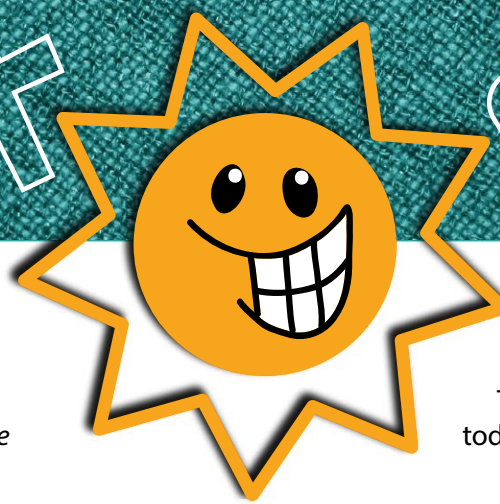

Read It:

Day 4



Jehovah Rocks:

When I think of all the things I could give my time or thoughts to, none are as important as when I spend time praising You. (Psalm 33:1)

Do It:

Try to pray a 'praise point' once every hour of your day today.

See It:

'When you sin, the pay you get is death. But God gives you the gift of eternal life because of what Christ Jesus our Lord has done.' (Romans 6:23)

On It:

When you get a job they'll start paying you money – a wage. But in Romans today we read that the wages of sin is death! So, a life of sin is paid up with death. Yesterday we learned that we have all sinned, so put that with today's lesson... and this is not good news for us! We have sinned, so we have to die!? No, wait! There is good news! God has a gift for us – eternal life! It's just the opposite from death. Woohoo! So, where do you pick up your gift? From the store? No! You get it direct from Jesus Christ our Lord! Believe me, it's the best gift you will ever receive. You won't even need to keep the receipt!

Live It:

The third colour of the flag is yellow, which represents the third part of the Trinity; God the Holy Spirit. Why yellow? The Holy Spirit is often shown by fire because the Holy Spirit fires up with a passion for soul saving mission!



In It:

Praise You Holy Spirit! You are so powerful!

Eat It: (Memorize the verse)

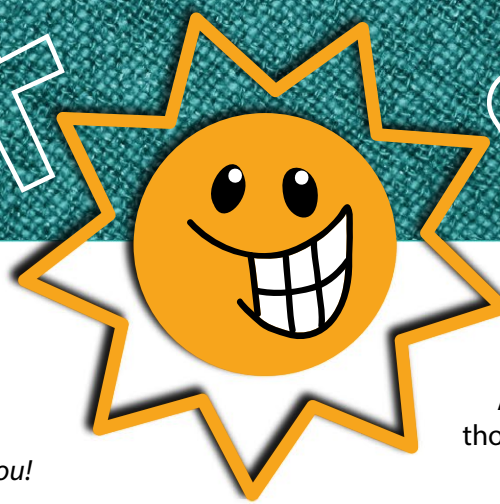

Day 5



Jehovah Rocks:

When I think of You, I want to praise You in so many different ways so that You know how awesome I think You are. I want to sing and dance and make songs for You!
(Psalm 33:2)

See It:

'Just as people are destined to die once, and after that to face judgement.' (Hebrews 9:27)

On It:

Alright, so a lot is going on here. First, we all die. You expected that, right? But that also means that we don't come back as a mouse, or a cow or even another human. We die once, and that's enough for me! Then what happens? We face judgement. That's right. God will judge us for all that we've done in that life. Oh dear! What are we going to do? The only smart way to head into judgement before God is with Jesus in your life. And since you don't ever know when you are heading into judgement, it is best to make sure you have Jesus in your life. Are you ready? Have a little think over it, and talk about it with someone today.

Live It:

In the center of the flag it says 'blood and fire'. These two words explain our mission as The Salvation Army. The blood of Jesus shows we are fighting for the salvation of everyone in the world! Getting people saved is the reason we exist. It is our purpose and our mission.

Do It:

Talk to one friend about how Jesus takes away your sin.

In It:

Ask for forgiveness of your sins and then say 'thank you' that those sins are now gone forever!

Jehovah Rocks:

*You are so great that I want to tell You all of the time!
I don't want to let a minute go by without telling you how
amazing I think you are. (Psalm 34:1)*

See It:

'There is a way that may seem right to a man. But in the end it leads to death.' (Proverbs 14:12)

On It:

Do you know what? A lot of people out there think they have the right way worked out. They think that we should always get our own way, we should not have to do homework, we should get as many toys as we can, we should worship a little statue or a guy on the TV screen with a number on his back, or... They figure that if we do one of those things we will win in the end. But the Bible says here that all of those ways end up in death! And that's death for a really long time! Ahhhh! Don't depend on your own way or your own plan. Depend on God. Get it? Maybe read yesterday's again if it's foggy, and then talk to someone who is a Christian about it if that doesn't help.

Live It:

Yesterday we learned that in the 'Blood and Fire' motto, the blood stands for salvation. Well, the fire stands for sanctification through the Holy Spirit. What does that mean? I'll tell you tomorrow!

Do It:

Tell somebody at school about The Salvation Army flag.

In It:

Ask God for something you need help with.

Dear God, please help me...

Eat It:

'The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.' (John 10:10) Jesus came to give us full life! Praise God! Please get rid of my sin, Jesus, so that I can be filled with life!

Read It:

One-year Bible Plan: Read Genesis 49-50, Psalm 8, & Luke 20

Week 3

Day 7



Jehovah Rocks:

I want to tell others how much I love You. I am going to stand up in front of a huge group of people and tell them all how wonderful You are, because You are so fantastic that everyone should know it! (Psalm 35:18)

See It:

'Christ died for our sins once and forever. The One who only ever does what is right died for those who don't do what is right. He died to bring you to God. His body was put to death. But the Holy Spirit brought Him back to life.' (1 Peter 3:18)

On It:

Jesus Christ died for us. He died for you! Imagine that! Actually, you don't have to...He did it for real! He lived a perfect life. He did not deserve to be punished. Have you lived a perfect life? Never told a lie, and never been mean to anyone? I think I can safely say that you and I have not lived a perfect life. And we do deserve the consequences of our sins, as harsh as that sounds. But, we don't have to stay far from God! Why? Because Jesus died for us! And the reason He did it? So that you can be with God. He takes away the yucky sin in our life, forgiving it, and He replaces it with tasty loving goodness! Don't waste His sacrifice by not asking for forgiveness. Talk to God and ask Him to stay close to you today!

Live It:

The Holy Spirit wants to sanctify us, which means He wants to clean you out, and keep you clean. God's grace means we can always ask for forgiveness, but once we are completely or wholly sanctified, we can be free from sinning forever!

Do It:

Ask God to show you any sins remaining in your life. When He does, ask for His forgiveness. Tell God you are finished with those sins from now on. Tell any demons who bug you through those sins to go away forever in Jesus' name. And ask God to sanctify you.

In It:

Another prayer for you to read from the songbook (795):

'We'll tear hell's throne to pieces and win the world for Jesus. We'll be conquerors forever for we never will give in!'



Eat It:

Can you recite John 10:10? 'The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.' Do you know what? Once you have received salvation from Jesus, you are free! And satan can't do anything about it! Take that, you silly little thief!

Read It:
