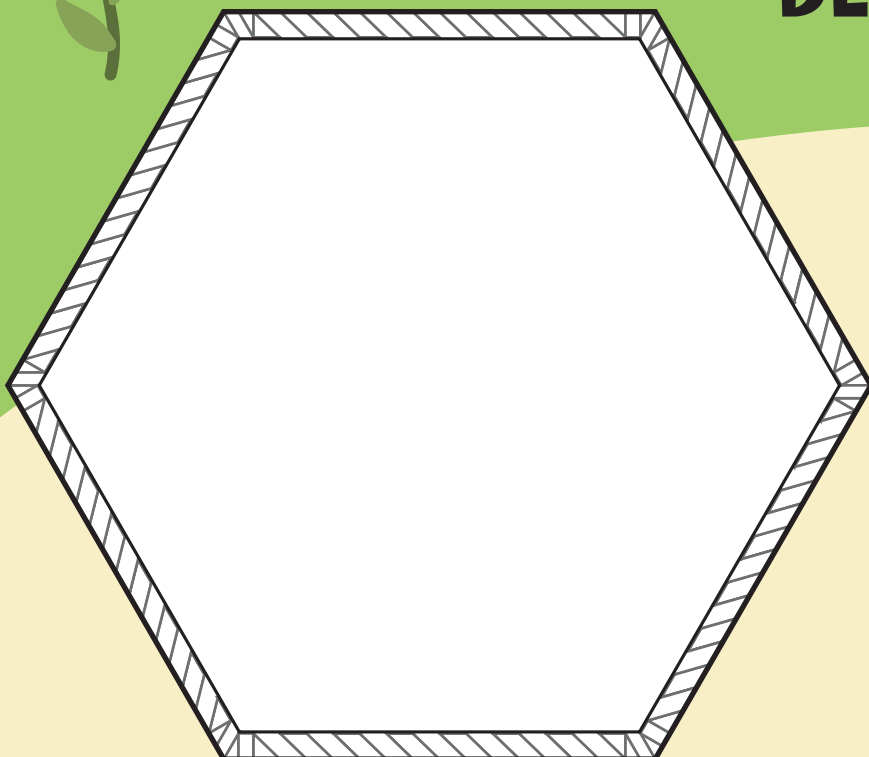

You could include:

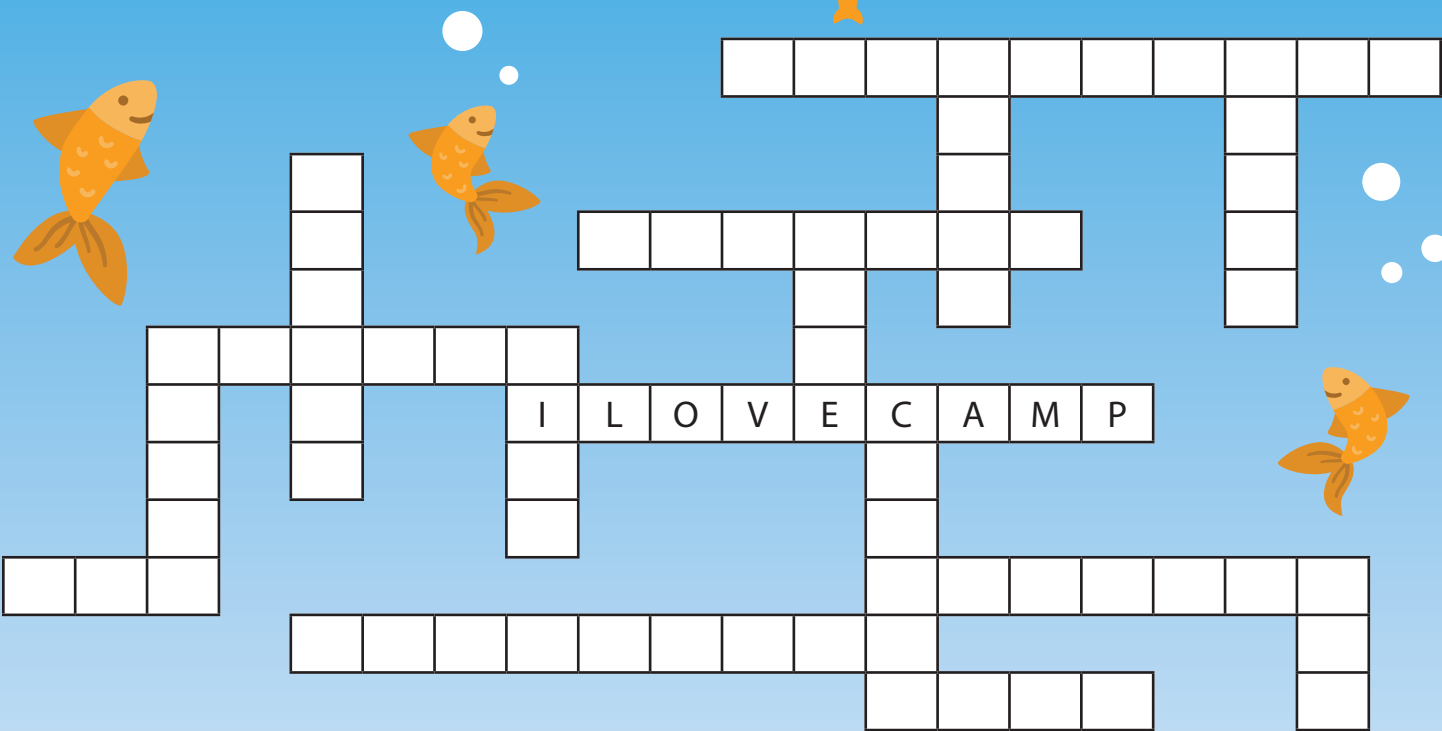
- The name of the camp

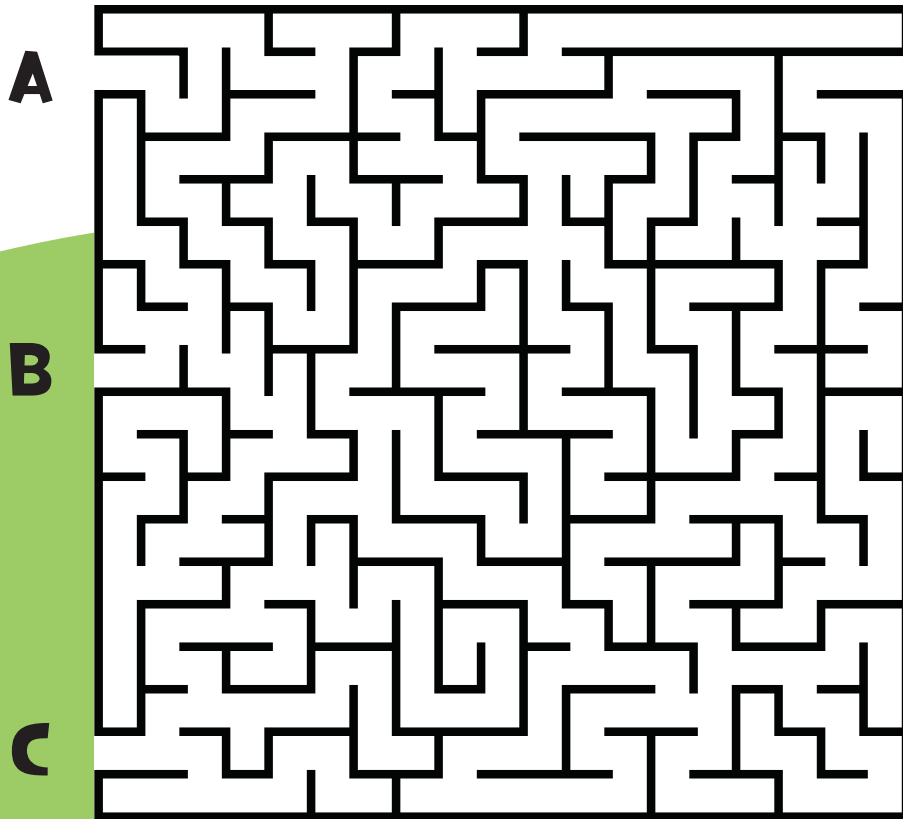
