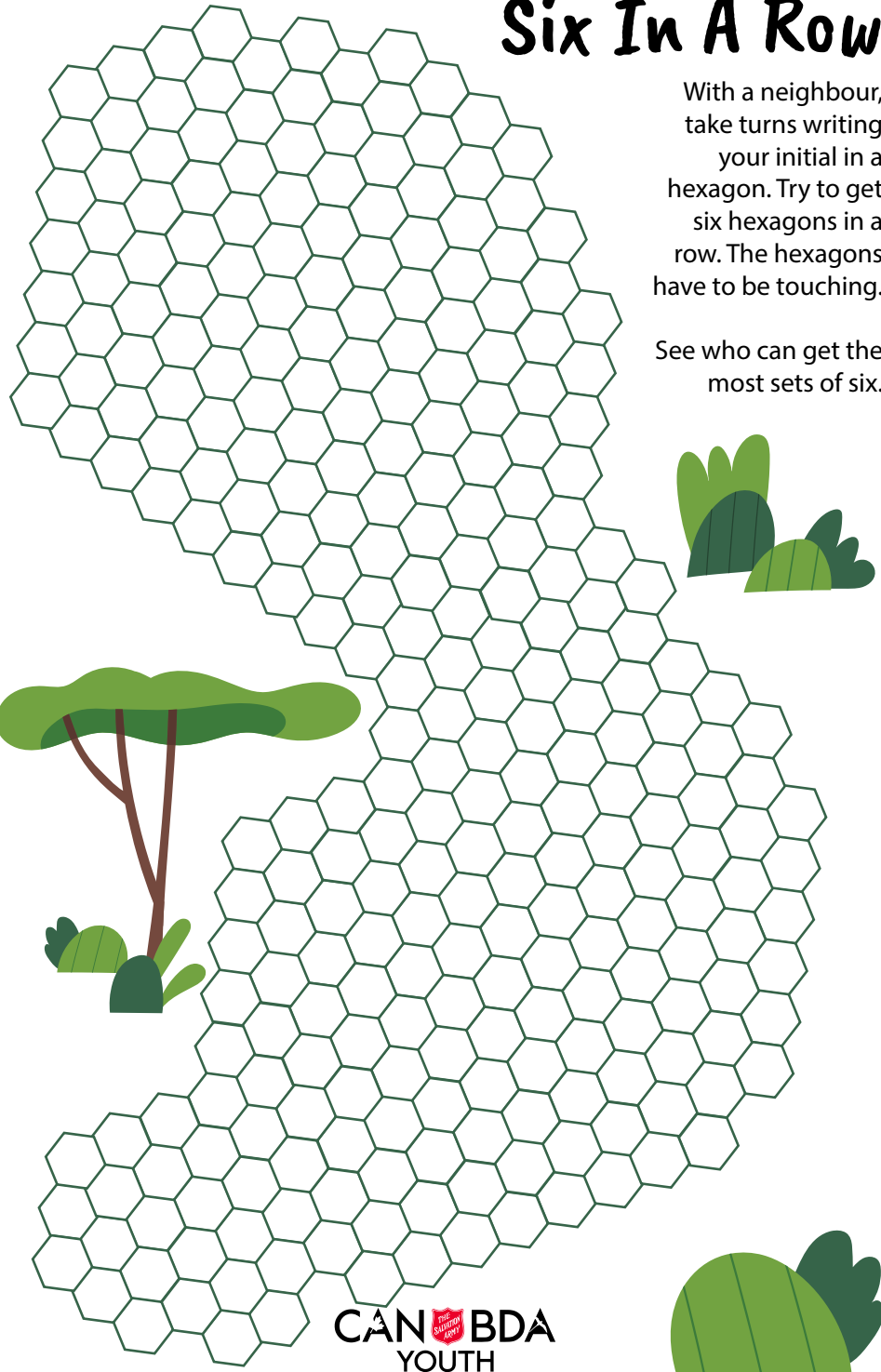


# Six In A Row

Challenge your neighbour's memory! Give your neighbour 30 seconds to look at the pictures. Then have them tell you what they remember. See how many they remember correctly.

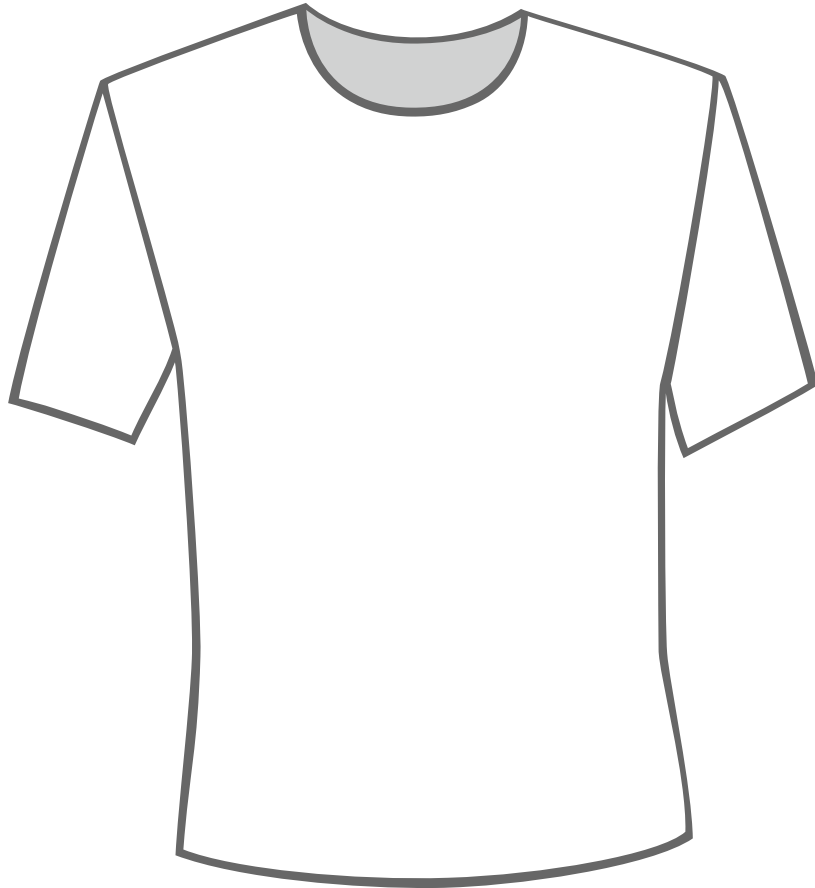




# Designer Camp Tees
