



VISION iPad TASK IDEAS

For each child, print out an iPad on cardstock, and a set of stickers on labels (e.g. Avery 2309 from Staples/ Amazon etc.). Set up 8 stations for the Vision tasks, with a leader present near each to award stickers.

Here are some simple station ideas. As children complete each station, they receive a sticker to stick in the appropriate place on their iPad.

1. (With a partner) Each child must do something that can only be done with more than one person, e.g. tie a shoelace when each person only uses one hand; pick up an item with one chopstick per person, etc.
2. Give each child a piece of paper with some random lines/shapes drawn on it. Using those lines they must come up with a creative, new picture.
3. Each child must match two pairs of cards in a memory game (can use icons, or a regular card memory matching game)
4. Each child must find a small car hidden in the room, and drive it along the ground to the mobilize point (mark a point on the floor as the mobilize point). Alternatively, each child must make a paper aeroplane, and fly it into the mobilize point (a bucket).
5. Draw/write a way to share hope
6. Choose a hardship from a list (or images stuck to a wall) and pray for people with that hardship.
7. Build a community with lego/blocks/Jenga blocks. Each child gets the same number of bricks to use.
8. Find and recite a bible verse related to the icon, e.g. Romans 8:38-39 or Romans 5:8
