PRAYER PROMPTS

We recognize not every corps has individuals who are exploring full-time vocational ministry, however, we are still part of God's greater story of calling. While you may not give full emphasis to Call and Commitment Sunday, you are invited to pray, standing shoulder to shoulder with others across our territory, praying for God to raise up men and women who will say yes to His calling on their lives, and that His church will never lack faithful workers for the harvest.

Let us pray with expectancy that hearts will be stirred, leaders will be raised up, and that together, we will continue to be a people ready to say, "Yes, Lord."

Below are several prayer prompts you can use to guide your time of reflection and intercession.

- Ask God to send workers into the harvest as Jesus prayed (in Matthew 9:38).
- Pray for a quiet and receptive heart to hear God's voice.
- Pray for individuals who are discerning God's calling on their lives that they would experience His abiding peace.
- Pray that fear, doubt or feelings of inadequacy will not silence God's call.
- Pray that hearts will remain open to whatever God asks of them.
- Pray for hearts willing to surrender plans, comfort, or security in obedience to God's call.

- Pray for readiness to join God's mission.
- Pray for cadets currently in training that they would be strengthened and equipped.
- Pray for the work of the Candidates Department for creative vision, wisdom, clarity in decision–making, that their work will inspire a culture of calling, and sensitivity to the Holy Spirit's leading as they encourage and guide others in their calling.
- Pray for a united spirit in raising up leaders.
- Thank God that every believer has a unique part in His mission.
- Pray for your congregation that God would renew in them a sense of sacred purpose in everyday ministry and service.
