A Call To Prayer

60-Minute Prayer Guide



Entering His Presence

Wait before the Lord in worshipful silence. Quiet your heart and be still before Him. Breathe slowly and deeply, acknowledging that He is with you. Sometimes it's good to speak out loud, saying something like "God, You are here with me. You are here in me. You are here all around me. I embrace Your presence." Speak the name of Jesus and let the joy of being His child settle upon you.

Call 10 Prayer

Invitation:

Come to Me. Come to Me. Come to Me. This is My continual invitation to you, proclaimed in holy whispers. When your heart and mind are quiet, you can hear Me inviting you to draw near. Coming close to Me requires no great effort on your part; it is more like ceasing to resist the magnetic pull of My love. Open yourself to My loving presence, so that I may fill you with My fullness. I want you to experience how wide and long and high and deep is My love for you, so that you can know My love that surpasses knowledge. This vast ocean of love cannot be measured or explained, but it can be experienced.

Praise

Lead The Mond

Slowly and prayerfully read **Romans 12** (*taken from Epistles Now*) allowing the words to echo and resonate, sink in and settle into your heart.

Celebration must be combined with service. The relationship between us and God is a two-way street. Our great God gives; we must respond to His gracious gifts. Our response is the offering of our lives, the placing of ourselves at His disposal, for the accomplishment of His purposes in the world about us.

We are, once we acknowledge God's love and accept His salvation, under new management. This is what worship is all about. It is not confined to loud singing or verbal exclamations. It is turning our hearts, minds, and bodies over to God's ownership, and dedicating our abilities and gifts to His service. We have all received such gifts for this very purpose. They are committed to us in order to be committed back to God in and through and by way of service to others for God's sake. This is precisely the way in which our God meets the needs of our neighbor – through us and through these gifts entrusted to us.

We all have specific abilities. We are to exercise these things upon one another and on behalf of one another. We are to allow God to reach and touch others with His care and concern for them through us.

Meditate On the Mond

Using prayerful meditation on God's Word, we learn to tune in to what God might be saying, allow Scripture to transform us, and inform our prayers. As you reflect on Romans 12, prayerfully consider these questions:

- What word, phrase or image is God drawing out of this passage for you?
- What is the Lord saying to you through this word, phrase or image?
- What invitation is God extending to you from this passage?

Respond from your heart to what God has revealed to you in His Word.
