Beauty

Restoration

Ask: Where is the crowd that you invite me to see, that perhaps I have not seen before? Who needs your restoring grace?

Plant

Lord Jesus, the field is your world. You are planting seeds through your people in so many places, even in remote corners. You invite us to plant seeds of the good news gospel.

Ask: Where is the field/corner you are calling me to? Would you show me where I might best use my gifts and talents to plant, water and/or harvest?



Harvest



Lord Jesus, you said to your disciples that, "The harvest is" plentiful, but the workers are few."

Ask: Jesus, because of your saving work we can work for you. Why do we, your people, sometimes resist working for you? Do I/we need to say sorry to you?

Plentiful

Lord Jesus, you said the harvest was plentiful.

Ask: Is the harvest still plentiful?

Lord Jesus, you saw the crowds and you saw your disciples. You invited them to ask that the fields would have workers. You were inviting them to say, "Here I am, send me" and inviting others to say, "Here I am, send me."

Ask: I turn my face towards you, the risen son of God, I join with many voices asking that you would send more workers into the field. Also, inspire me to invite others to serve you.
