### Event description:

Brave is an event with the aim to educate and empower young girls. The goal is to reach the most vulnerable and at-risk youth in our communities across Canada. This is a community outreach initiative.

### What are the intended event outcomes?

This event is structured to deliver a message of hope, love, value and purpose. This is achieved by bringing in guest speakers, visual artists, dancers, self-defense experts and community leaders who themselves have walked through adversity and can clearly demonstrate that there is light at the end of the tunnel. Each Brave event also features a whole host of community volunteers that help every attendee feel special and loved.

### How will these outcomes be evaluated?

The aim is to build connection with these girls; not to simply offer a one-day event but to continue with BRAVE circles throughout the year.

### What procedures are required to set up this event?

Contact your divisional women's leader. The division supplies tools and resources to start your event.



## What procedure is required to operate this event?

- Contact divisional leader.
- Understand purpose of the event.
- Do any necessary training (vulnerable sector training).
- Contact community groups (schools, vulnerable girl groups, SA community family services, etc.).
- Have fun!

## Are there financial costs attached to providing this program?

The cost depends on what the leader plans for the day. Most cost will come from food, giveaways, crafts, t-shirts, etc. The average cost that has been budgeted is \$30 per girl.

## What physical resources will I require?

This depends on what is planned for the event. Divisional or territorial women's ministries can be consulted.

## Would any additional training be necessary for volunteers with this program?

- Vulnerable sector screening.
