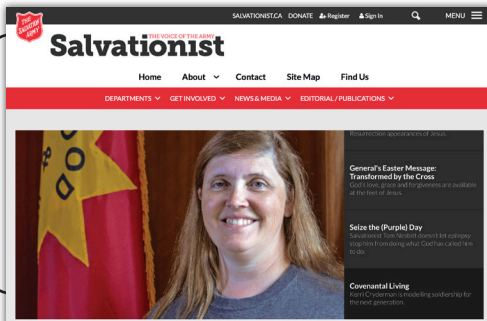
A Match Made in Heaven
