Raqiya struggled to find a way forward after immigrating to Canada until The Salvation Army gave her a Pathway of Hope.



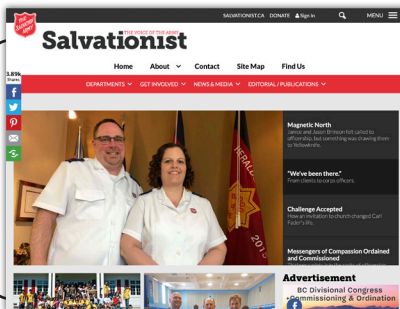

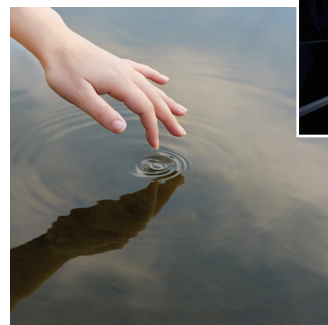
