When Jesus was here on earth, He did many wonderful things. He healed people who were sick. He gave food to people who were hungry. And He taught people to love each other, as He loved them.

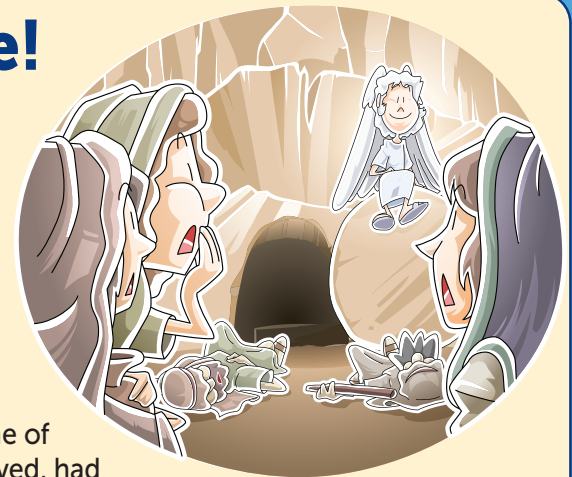
But not everyone loved Jesus. Some of the leaders in Israel, where Jesus lived, had Him killed.

Jesus' friends felt very sad when He died. They didn't understand that Jesus chose to die in order to save them.

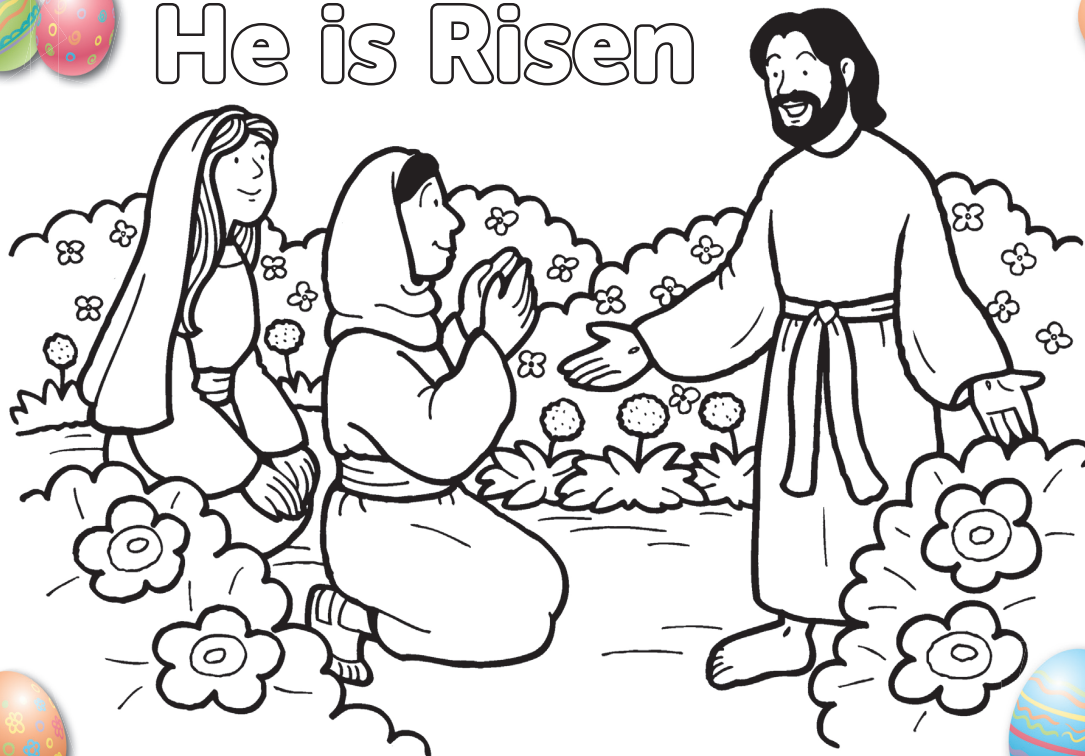
After Jesus died, His body was laid in a tomb. A big stone was rolled in front of the tomb, so no one could get in.

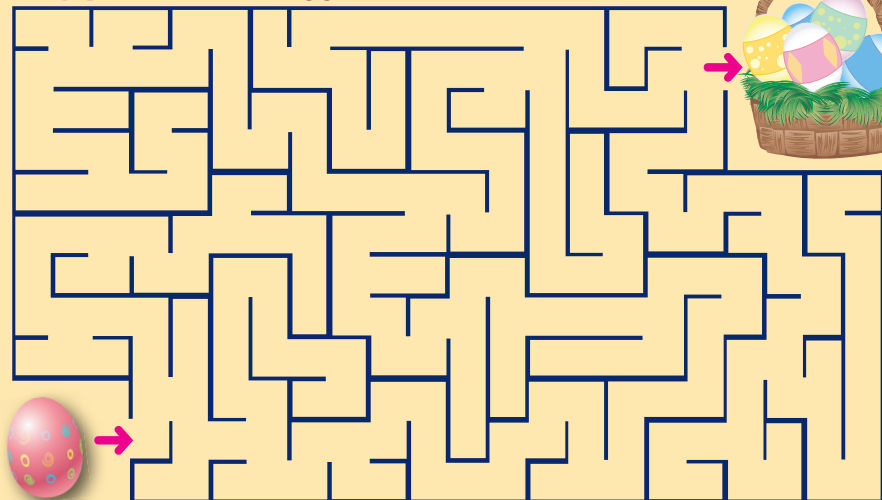
He is Risen

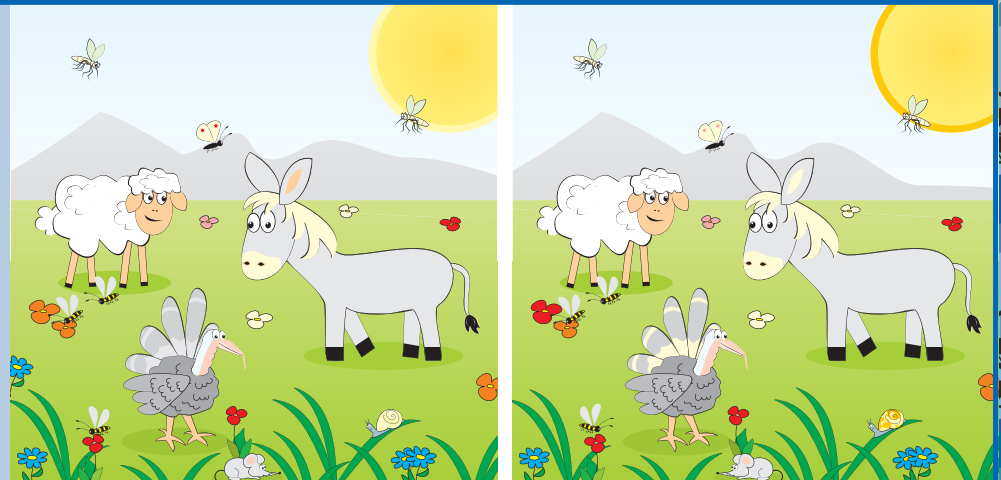
David gave the Lord's blessing to Abigail that day, saying, "You have shown a lot of good sense."

Abigail Saves the Day Crossword

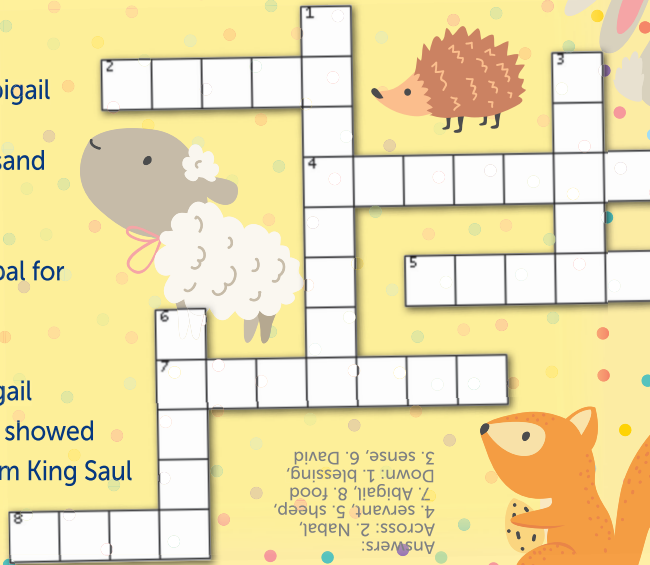

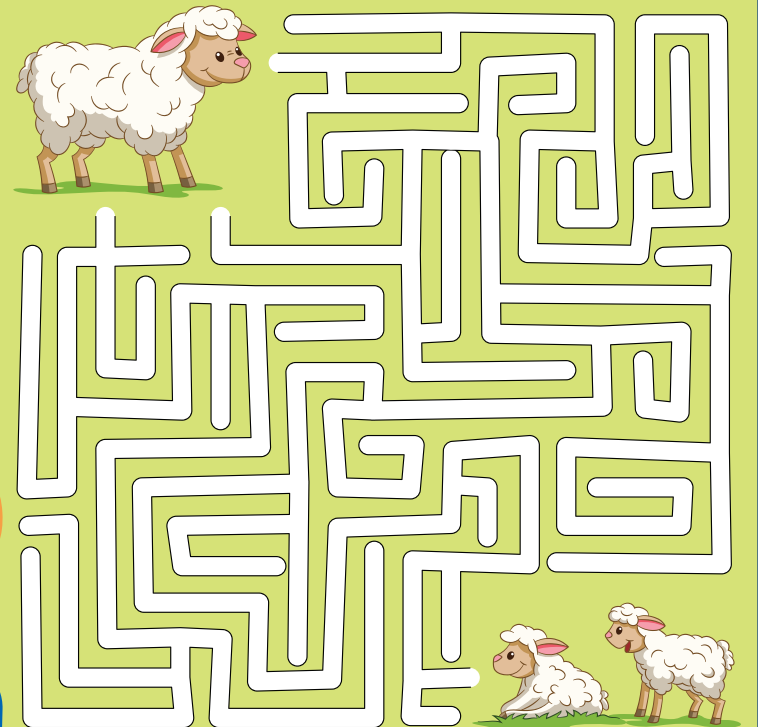
