All articles and short stories should contain Christian truths and contain conclusions that are consistent with biblical principles.

Our Editorial Needs

Short Stories – fictitious short stories (maximum 175 words) that feature true-to-life situations of children who are living their lives as young followers of Jesus Christ. An effort is made to ensure children from as many cultures and ethnic backgrounds as possible are highlighted in our stories.

Bible Lessons – straightforward and simple lessons (maximum 175 words) to help readers understand biblical truths.

Puzzles – for example, spot the differences, mazes, crossword puzzles, find the twins, shadow matching, and so on. Puzzles that relate to a biblical story or concept are preferred; however, we are also looking for puzzles that touch on common themes such as seasons (winter/spring/summer/fall), holidays (e.g. Christmas, Thanksgiving, Canada Day), and activities (e.g. sports, travelling, animals).

Please note that *Just for Kids* is not a magazine. Written submissions that are longer than the limit specified will not be considered.
