Just for Kids is written and designed in partnership with the Orange children's ministry curriculum to teach young people about God and help them understand what it means to be a Christian. It also provides information about what is happening with young Salvationists across Canada and Bermuda.

Editorial Content

News Photo With Caption (max. 75 words)

- Clear, high-resolution photo of a junior soldier enrolment, achievement or recognition of a young person or group ٠ of young people, a corps activity for or by young people, etc., with caption
- Caption must include the names and titles of everyone shown in the photo from left to right, what the occasion was and where it took place
- Permission must be received from the parents/guardians of all children shown in the photo before it is submitted for publication

Puzzles and Activities

- Original puzzles, including mazes, word searches, crossword puzzles and spot the differences, that relate to common themes (seasons, holidays, sports, animals, etc.), a biblical story or concept, and Salvation Army distinctives (junior soldiers, Salvation Army flag, etc.)
- Age-appropriate jokes and tongue twisters
- Age-appropriate general knowledge and Salvation Army trivia questions

Submissions should be sent to justforkids@salvationarmy.ca. If applicable, identify Scripture references and include sources for trivia questions, etc.

Just for Kids is edited according to the Canadian Press Stylebook, 2021 edition, and the Salvation Army Style Guide, 2021. New International Reader's Version (NIRV) is the standard Bible translation used.
