#### **Editorial Content**

#### Feature (max. 1,500 words)—Salvationist and Salvationist.ca

- Well-reasoned and thought-provoking essay, theological reflection or biblical interpretation
- Ministry unit profile, personal testimony or third-person account of another person's testimony
- Reflections on Salvation Army distinctives, history, and mission and ministry

## News Report (200-400 words)—Salvationist and Salvationist.ca

- Brief report of an event, program or activity that is of significant interest to the territory
- Include the "who, what, when, where, why and how" of the event, program or activity
- Supportive, clear, high-resolution photos are appreciated

### News Photo With Caption (max. 150 words)—Salvationist

- Clear, high-resolution photo of an enrolment, achievement, recognition or corps activity with caption
- Include the names and titles of everyone shown in the photo, occasion and location

#### Tribute (max. 200 words)—Salvationist

- · Tributes are printed at no cost as space permits
- Should be received within three months of the promotion to glory
- Include where the person lived, conversion to Christ, corps involvement, Christian ministry and survivors
- Clear, high-resolution photo or high-resolution scan of a clear printed photo may be submitted as desired

Submissions should be sent to salvationist@salvationarmy.ca as an attached Microsoft Word document in standard manuscript form: double-spaced; name, address, telephone number and email address in top left-hand corner; word count in top right-hand corner. If your article is "as told to," include name, telephone number and email address of the person who is the subject of the story.

Identify Scripture references and version of the Bible used in parenthesis within the text of your article. Sources for quotations or general comments attributed to other persons must also be included.

Salvationist is edited according to the Canadian Press Stylebook, 2021 edition, and the Salvation Army Style Guide, 2021. New International Version (NIV) is the standard Bible translation used.
