EASTER'S GOOD NEWS

In a few short weeks we will be celebrating Easter. We'll be hosting egg hunts, early morning breakfasts, and we'll have the privilege of sharing the good news of Easter with our students. Here's a quick reminder of what each egg colour represents. Be sure to download the resource to get the complete teaching guide.



Blue - Reminds us that God created the world and everything that is in it, including each of us. God's creation was perfect. In John 1:3 tells us that: "Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made."



Purple - Reminds us of bruises, and they can really hurt. When we are disobedient or sin, we hurt our hearts and break our perfect relationship with God. In Romans 3:23 we read: "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."



Red (or Pink) - Reminds us that Jesus chose to obey God's plan. He bled and died on the cross for us. He did this to take the punishment for all of people's sin. It's because of Jesus' death that our broken relationship with God can be repaired. In Romans 5:8 we read: "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." After three days God raised Jesus back to life. He now lives in Heaven with God.



Green - Reminds me that God will give us a fresh start at having a relationship with Him. In 1 John 1:9 in the Bible we read: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us from all unrighteousness."



Orange - Reminds us of construction and building something new. There are different things we can do to help us build up our relationship with God. We can build it by spending time with God reading the Bible. We can pray or talk to God anytime, anywhere and about anything. We can also build it by spending time with others who have chosen to follow Jesus. The Bible tells us in 1 John 2:6 that: "Whoever claims to live in Him must live as Jesus did."



Yellow - Reminds us of gold. The Bible tells us that Heaven has streets of gold, and that Jesus lives in Heaven with God. He wants us to live in Heaven with Him one day. John 3:16 reminds us of God's plan for each of us: "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."
