## **CONDITIONS FOR JUNIOR SOLDIERSHIP IN THE SALVATION ARMY**

A child may be accepted for junior soldiership if the following conditions have been met:

1. Sufficient time (at least one month) has been allowed for initial preparation and evidence of true conversion.
2. (S)he is clearly committed to service as a salvationist (normally this will mean no membership of any other church).
3. (S)he is not less than seven years of age.
4. (S)he has successfully completed the preparation course for junior soldiership.
5. (S)he understands and signs the junior soldier promise.
