28 Days of Prayer

Call & Commitment Month
February 2023

- 1st Thank God that you are His handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works (see Ephesians 2:10).
- 2nd Pray that God's people would be awake to the story He is writing in their lives.
- 3rd Pray for a deepening intimacy with Christ. Pray that we will continue to live in Him, rooted and built up in Him, and be strengthened in the faith (Colossians 2:6-7).
- 4th As God speaks to His people, pray that their ears would be attuned to hear His voice, whether it comes as a gentle whisper or like the roar of rushing waters. Pray that they'll give their full undivided attention to His voice.
- 5th *Breath Prayer*
Inhale: You created my inmost being.
Exhale: I am fearfully and wonderfully made.
(From Psalm 139:13-14)
- Meditate on this truth as you pray and rest today.
- 6th Pray for a posture of attentiveness and humility as people discern God's will for their lives.
- 7th Pray against self-doubt and ask God to help His people embrace the truth that they are divinely and extraordinarily created.
- 8th Pray for an overwhelming sense of "God's infinite Majesty that His people would be compelled to throw themselves on the ground and offer themselves as a blank in His hands, to write on it what He pleased." (Words of George Whitefield)

9th Meditate on the fact that God knows exactly how we are formed. Ask Him to open your eyes to the way He wants to use your gifts for His purposes.

10th Pray for courage to withstand every “what if” as God’s people consider His will for their lives.

11th Pray that people will resist comparison with others, and that they’ll stay focused on their own unique calling and gifts.

12th *Breath Prayer*

Inhale: I can do all things,

Exhale: through Christ who gives me strength.

(From Philippians 4:13)

Meditate on this truth as you pray and rest today.

13th Pray for a quieting of all the question marks, and a deepening of trust and faith in God and dependence on the Holy Spirit to continually guide and empower.

14th As people consider God’s will for their lives, pray for courage in releasing their grasp on all that is familiar and comfortable, finding freedom in surrender.

15th Pray for the ministry of mentors and sacred companions who offer encouragement, counsel and prayer support.

16th Ask God to release us from all that would ‘get in the way’ (both small & big things) of doing what He is asking of us.

17th Pray for acknowledgement of the gentle reminders/signposts that God is present, that He is working in the enigma of who we are, to shape us into the person we were always meant to become.

18th Pray that people will take their eyes off everything they think they need, and that they will be amazed instead at God’s grace and provision.

19th *Breath Prayer*

Inhale: I trust the plans You have for me.

Exhale: You give me hope and a future.

(From Jeremiah 29:11)

Meditate on this truth as you pray and rest today.

- 20th Spend some time today reflecting on what it means for you to be God's workmanship. What does He want you to know, receive, and to do? Talk with Him about these things.
- 21st Pray for candidates currently in the application process for 2023. Pray for a deep-settled peace as they offer themselves for fulltime service.
- 22nd Ask God to help His people trust Him with all their heart instead of depending on their own understanding (see Proverbs 3:5).
- 23rd Pray for the mission and ministry of CFOT.
- 24th Pray that God will fulfill His purposes for you (see Psalm 138:8).
- 25th Pray for a voice of affirmation to be spoken over God's people as they yield to His perfect will.
- 26th *Breath Prayer*
Inhale: I am no longer my own.
Exhale: I am yours.
- Meditate on this truth as you pray and rest today.
- 27th Pray that God will draw His people into a place where they can finally say "yes" to Him and live fully into His calling on their lives.
- 28th Pray that God's people will rest in their identity as His children; that they will rest in His constant presence and faithful provision; that they will rest in His trustworthy promises.
