During the four weeks of Call and Commitment month, use this guide to text a Scripture verse to members of your congregation/leadership team for them to reflect on/pray through. Possible verses are provided here.

Week #1

“You are our Father. We are just clay, and You are the potter. We are the product of Your creative action, shaped and formed into something of worth.” Isaiah 64:8, The Voice

Visualize your life as a studio of the Divine Potter and know that His hands are on your heart. Ask God to have His own way in your life as He shapes- and reshapes-you into His wonderful image. Let Him do a mighty work of art with your life.

Week #2

“For we are His workmanship [His own master work, a work of art], created in Christ Jesus [reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, ready to be used] for good works, which God prepared [for us] beforehand [taking paths which He set], so that we would walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us].” Ephesians 2:10, AMP

God is no amateur potter, but an artisan who has already begun to shape us into a masterpiece. He sees potential in us that we cannot envision. He has hope for us far beyond our expectations. He will use us to do more than we imagine, if we allow Him to work in and through us.

Ponder:

Do you think of yourself as God’s handiwork, as a work of art that He’s perfecting?

How is God shaping your life right now? Where is He smoothing rough edges?

Where is He strengthening and polishing you?
