**OFFICER PATHWAY** 

# STANDARD TRAINING (CADET)\*

Length of Training: Two years.

**Location:** College for Officer Training (CFOT), Greater Toronto Area.

Theological Formation: In-person and virtual coursework.

**Mission and Ministry Formation:** Cadets will be assigned a home-based corps within an hour commute of CFOT, serving under the supervision and mentorship of an approved field-training officer.

**Spiritual Life Development:** Spiritual formation classes, chapels, personal and community holiness practices. Participation with in-Sunday services and other CFOT events.

\*Standard training is the expected training program for cadets.

**OFFICER PATHWAY** 

### **AUXILIARY-CAPTAIN**

**Length of Training:** Up to seven years in full-time appointment while completing the requirements for a certificate of officership and demonstrating the character and competency of an officer.

Location: Canada and Bermuda Territory.

**Criteria:** Demonstrated character, capacity and experience to assume responsibility of a ministry unit and carry appointment responsibilities while completing the training requirements of the auxiliary-captain program.

**Spiritual Life Development:** Will participate in divisional spiritual life development events, attend two CFOT in-Sunday services a year and invest in personal holiness practices.

## TAILORED TRAINING (CADET)\*

Length of Training: Flexible.

Location: Canada and Bermuda Territory; Quebec (for training in French).

This training pathway offers a high level of flexibility and a fully customizable approach to training. In exceptional circumstances, individualized programs may be developed, resulting in variations in duration, content and delivery methods. These customizations are based on several factors, including the candidate's personal, professional and educational circumstances, the availability of CFOT resources, and specific territorial needs. Modifications must align with and meet the standards prescribed by the Orders and Regulations for the Training and Development of Salvation Army Officers.

#### **ENVOY**

Onboarding: Determined by ministry unit and/or division.

Location: Local/Divisional.

**Criteria:** Demonstrated character and capacity to fulfil appointment responsibilities. Called upon or offers to provide leadership in part-time or full-time capacity.

**Spiritual Life Development:** Will participate in divisional spiritual life development events and invest in personal holiness practices.

NON-OFFICER PATHWAY

#### **AUXILIARY-LIEUTENANT**

Onboarding: Two-week orientation and training specific to appointment responsibilities. Training and development specific to the needs of each auxiliary-lieutenant will continue throughout the term of service.

Term of Active Service: Minimum of three years; reviewed after each three-year term to a maximum of nine years.

Location: Local/Divisional/Territorial.

Criteria: Demonstrated character, capacity and experience to assume leadership of a ministry unit and carry out appointment responsibilities.

Spiritual Life Development: Will participate in divisional spiritual life development events and invest in personal holiness practices.
