Gideon & the Fleece

Questions for Reflection & Discussion:

**Have I been doubtful or hesitant about a call the Lord has placed upon my life?
Have I been making excuses to avoid obedience?**

Is there any discrepancy between how I see myself and how God sees me relative to his call upon my life?

After a good obedient start, Gideon paused and challenged the Lord again about his calling. Does this in any way reflect my own experience?

What “fleece” have I put out in an effort to challenge or test the Lord’s call upon my life?

Matthew Henry in his commentary on Judges 6 said that now, under the dispensation of the Holy Spirit we should not ask for such a sign as Gideon did. But rather we should pray and ask God for a sign in our heart by the powerful working of the Holy Spirit within us. How might this sign in my heart look, sound, or feel?

Is there some “fleece” that I have put out that I need to gather back, or even throw away?
