

The @theREADY framework is a longterm discipleship strategy for the Canada and Bermuda territory, designed to resource ministries in their disciple-making efforts. We want to help you make *CHRIST-centred*, *OTHERS-focused* disciples who are @theREADY to live as followers of Jesus in their world. The framework provides specific resources and programming ideas, as well as biblically sound, age-appropriate teaching for each phase of a young person's development. Here are some answers to some of the most frequently asked questions about the @theREADY framework:

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WHAT TYPES OF RESOURCES ARE 💩 PART OF THE FRAMEWORK?

The framework includes:

- a combination of various curricular and family resources created by Orange (see @theREADY Orange Overview) and enhanced with SA distinctives;

- materials developed "in-house" to support soldiership and Salvationist-specific programming and leadership training; and

- intentional divisional and territorial youth initiatives.

IS THIS ANOTHER PROGRAM?

No, it's not a program in itself; it's much more than that! It's resources, curriculum, and strategy. It provides a combination of tools to help your programming be even more intentional.

WHAT AGE GROUP DOES THIS RESOURCE?

We want to resource ministries and families for the first 25 years of a young person's life. We believe each phase has unique needs and opportunities for faith development. See the @theREADY framework chart for how various age groups are represented and resourced in this strategy.

No, the framework is designed to facilitate flexibility —you choose from the resource options to make a mix that is right for your setting. But it does provide a base discipleship curriculum that will be the new prescribed standard for the territory. How the base curriculum is used can vary from setting to setting.
