The truth will help us reflect more honestly on our shared history. The TRC’s Calls to Action offer opportunities for deep solidarity. The future must include honouring Indigenous rights and building and renewing nation-to-nation relationships.

This booklet is designed to help non-Indigenous communities begin on a path of reconciliation with Indigenous peoples. By learning and unlearning. By building relationships. By actively practicing reconciliation. By living out our commitment in worship, in prayer and in just action. KAIROS is with you on this journey, as together we strive to practice reconciliation.



Blanket Exercise Standard Edition

The KAIROS Blanket Exercise, with versions for youth and adults, is a hands-on way to explore the nation-to-nation relationship with Indigenous peoples in Canada, to work toward reconciliation, and to empower people to build bridges of understanding and respect. Created in 1997, the Blanket Exercise is a succinct overview of Indigenous history and rights that explores the major themes and findings of the 1996 Report of the *Royal Commission on Aboriginal Peoples* (RCAP).

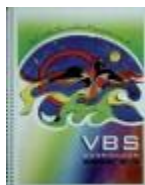

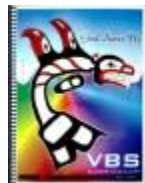
