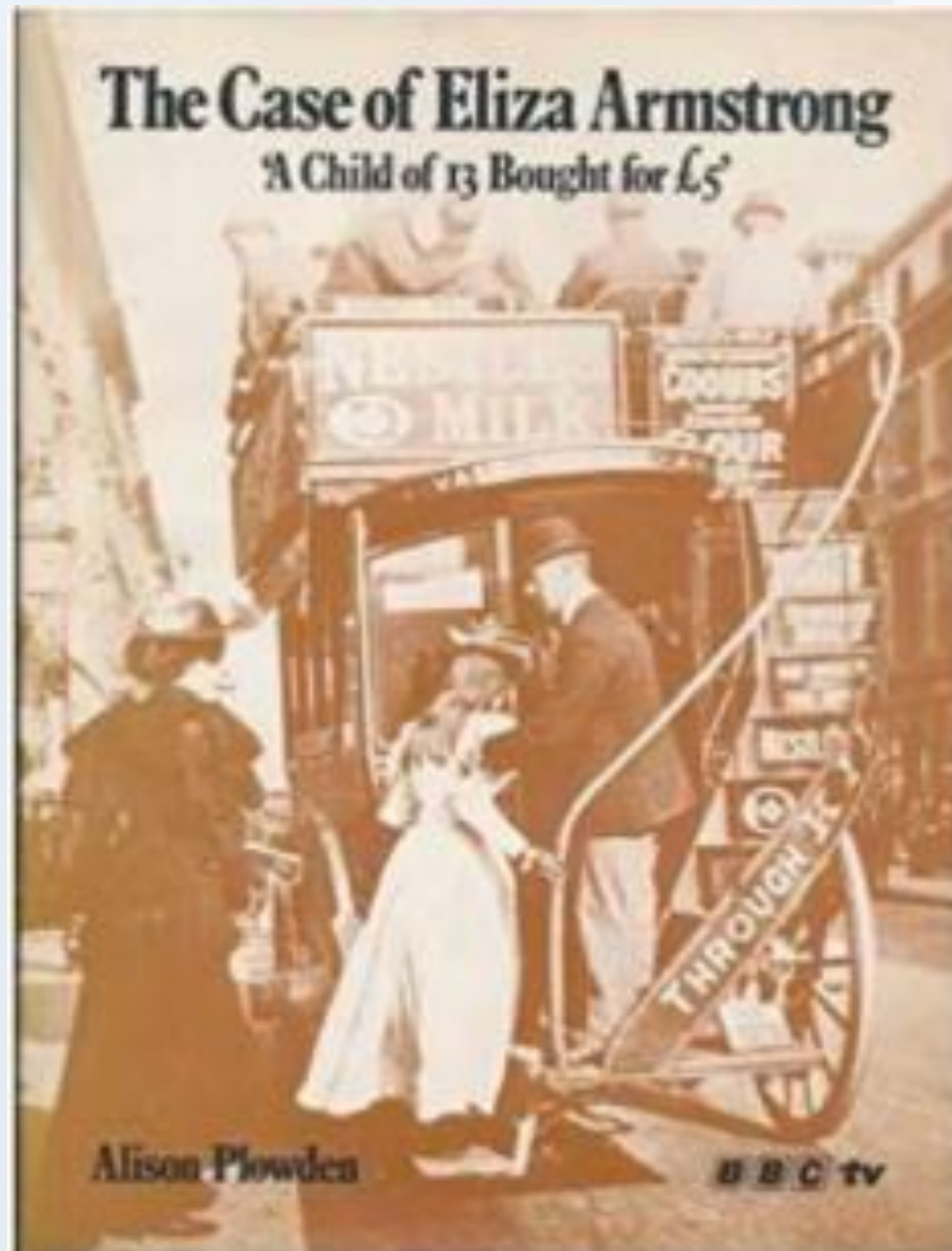

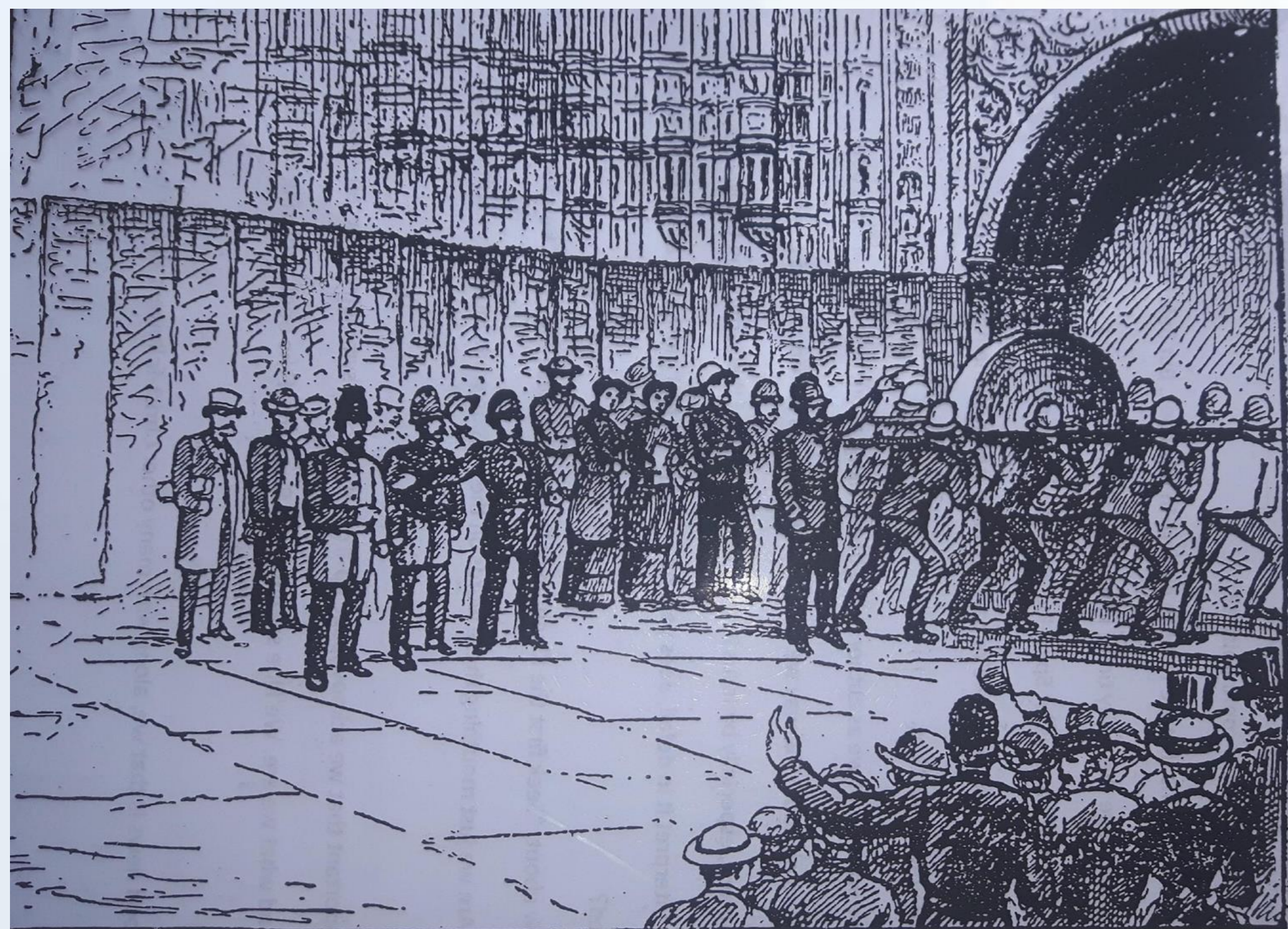
The Salvation Army women campaigned in the public square, giving voice to protect young girls.
