Jenea Gomez: The work that we do in response to modern slavery and human trafficking, it can be hard, and it can be heartbreakin, but

really, like, I don't get the option to not see it, and I don't get to look away, and I'm really, really grateful for that.

Jenea Gomez: So I want to share just a couple of statistics, I guess?

Jenea Gomez: the most recent global report that we have on trafficking in persons from the United Nations estimates that there is almost 50 million people, living in modern slavery of some sort in the world today.

Jenea Gomez: In 2024, there was a notable increase in the number of trafficking cases compared to pre-pandemic levels.

Jenea Gomez: One of the most significant trends, that was noticed was the sharp increase in forced labor. There was a 47% increase.

Jenea Gomez: within 2024, and as well, a surge in child trafficking cases. And this could be for so many reasons. You know, maybe the awareness that people are doing

Jenea Gomez: means that people are learning what human trafficking is. Maybe service providers are just connecting more with

Jenea Gomez: The cases that are out there, but in any case, it's a lot.

Jenea Gomez: Not all countries have standards around... the same standards around human trafficking, or even defining what slavery is. In 2024, law enforcement around the world was able to identify over 130,000 victims.

Jenea Gomez: Now, that's just the... just the cases that actually made it to law enforcement. There were 7,115 convictions globally.

Jenea Gomez: And 14 new or amended pieces of legislation related to human trafficking.

Jenea Gomez: In some ways, it feels like a drop in the bucket compared to the scope of a problem that we have.

Jenea Gomez: And yet, I know that, it takes an immense amount of labor and work

Jenea Gomez: And intentional coordination to get one conviction, and to have one piece of legislation amended or approved.

Jenea Gomez: And so, to have 715 convictions and 14 new pieces of legislation, or amended legislation.

Jenea Gomez: We have the Canadian Center to End Human Trafficking, and among many of the wonderful things that they do, they're commissioned by the government to collect statistics, to produce reports, that are able to paint a little bit of a picture for us nationally of the landscape of human trafficking within our borders.

Jenea Gomez: In 2025, their report indicated that sex trafficking remains the most common form of human trafficking, accounting for 69% of all identified cases within this country.

Jenea Gomez: Also noticed a huge increase in labor trafficking cases that were reported to the hotline.

Jenea Gomez: Within a 3-year period, there was a 700 and... no, 317% increase, that's a lot, within a 3-year period compared to the 3 years before that.

Jenea Gomez: Again, we don't know why the numbers keep rising. Maybe it's a good thing, because we can actually see.

Jenea Gomez: But it's not a small problem. It's... it's not a small problem that we have. I could stand here, and I could tell you stories about

Jenea Gomez: I could tell you about a mother that I've spoken to who made the painful decision to sell one of her children.

Jenea Gomez: I could tell you about a young woman who came to Vancouver from a northern rural community wanting to enjoy a football game, and then got swept up into the world of trafficking.

Jenea Gomez: I could tell you about a foreign worker who came to this country not knowing or understanding his rights, believing that the years he spent in debt bondage to his employer was lawful and his own fault.

Jenea Gomez: The reality that I can't not see every day is that when people say that human trafficking is hidden and pervasive, that means

Jenea Gomez: Always look like a sex worker, or an addict, or a criminal, and it rarely looks like someone in chains.

Jenea Gomez: Like a nanny, like a construction worker, like a nail artist, like a farm worker.

Jenea Gomez: Victims are recruited online, at school, by friends, often by family.

Jenea Gomez: Sometimes it's the very laws of our own countries and the pathways to entry and employment for foreigners that perpetuate the problem and protect traffickers. It's not a small problem.

Jenea Gomez: And that's just a little picture of what human trafficking looks like with our physical eyes.

Jenea Gomez: And even, you know, they say seeing is believing, but sometimes even just seeing physically can be hard, because we have our biases, and we have our assumptions, and we have our distractions that keep us veiled in some way to the things that are happening right in front of us.

Now, this isn't a Bible study, so I'm not going to get into breaking down everything that this means, but I will say, in some context, the person writing this is writing a letter to a church. So if you imagine yourself writing a letter to a worshiping community of

Jenea Gomez: Believers, and you're gonna say all the important things that you think that you need for them to know, and then you get to a place where you say, a final word.

Jenea Gomez: Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the strategies of the devil. For we are not fighting against flesh and blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world.

Jenea Gomez: And against evil spirits in the heavenly places.

And then he takes him on this wild journey, and he brings him to this clearing, and then there's this... this, you know, piece of water, this still water, and he tells him, look down there.

Jenea Gomez: And so Simba looks down into the water, and he sees, of course, his reflection, and he's like, that's not my dad, that's just my reflection.

Jenea Gomez: And that's the best way that I can describe for you the first thing that we need to do with this invitation to step up and pray, and that is to see. That's our first of three takeaways, to see. To see that

Jenea Gomez: What we experience in the physical is connected and influenced by what is happening in the spiritual. All the statistics and all the stories that we hear, there's something behind that that's happening.

Jenea Gomez: And that concept can be a little bit uncomfortable for some of us, sometimes, and... and I'm just gonna ask that you just lean into that uncomfortability, to look harder.

Jenea Gomez: People say to me oftentimes, you know, Janae, you're on the front lines, and you're doing the hard work, and the very least that I can do is pray. But it's not, it's not the least that we can do. It is really the thing that we get to do, that we can do.

Jenea Gomez: As important as it is for us to respond to human need in front of us, to feed the hungry, invite the stranger in, go to those imprisoned.

Jenea Gomez: It's important for us to uphold justice, to defend the oppressed, to be ministers of reconciliation, all those things Scripture instructs us to do, and we should do.

prayer is our primary weapon.

Jenea Gomez: which we read, 11, says, put on the full armor of God so that you will be able to stand against the strategies of the devil, who is our enemy. And so we have

Jenea Gomez: And what would be more strategic of an enemy than to minimize the potential impact of the greatest weapon that we have?

Jenea Gomez: And so... As we look to respond to the injustice of human trafficking through prayer.

Jenea Gomez: And also, beyond that, behind that, enabling that, fueling that, there are spiritual realities that we confront in prayer.

Jenea Gomez: So this is, this is the part where we're actually going to practice a little bit together. I thought it would be a bit silly to... to talk about stepping up and praying, and to talk about aligning ourselves to prayer, and then to not actually pray together. So,

Jenea Gomez: I'm gonna invite you to engage a little bit with me here. If you have a paper or a pen, you can feel free to get that. You certainly don't need it, but it might be helpful, you know, if you like to write things down.

Bergman, and it's just filled with angry prayers.

Jenea Gomez: When it comes to engaging in prayer for something like modern slavery, human trafficking, you might be filled with words, or you might not even know what to say. You might have nothing but, like, sighs and groans, and that is perfectly acceptable.

Jenea Gomez: But where we want to start is in aligning ourselves with God's will. And the easiest way, and again, probably one of the most powerful ways that we can do that is to use His Word.

Jenea Gomez: We can pray the Bible, we can say back to God what He has already said to us. Actually, in Ephesians 6, when Paul is in the context of that scripture that we read, he's talking to the church about putting on the full armor. One of those includes the sword of
