In the Italy & Greece Command, a small group of 27 active and 18 retired officers engage in the mission of The Salvation Army. In Athens, work with refugees continues to be at the forefront of ministry. Rental of a clothing warehouse, and the opening of a distribution centre helped to meet this great need. In Italy, the refugee centre helped people complete their applications and gain new skills. Many of those helped were able to find work, and start a new life.

Canadian Officers Captains Rachele Lamont & Jean-Curtis Plante & their two young sons live & work in Athens, Greece. They minister as Corps Officers at Athens corps, and in addition, Rachele is the Anti-Trafficking Coordinator and heads up the Green Light Project, which is aimed at getting women from the red light district off the streets. Jean-Curtis's role also includes being the Regional Business and Administration Officer. The Jan. 2018 Salvationist magazine article, "Off the Streets" profiles their important, life-saving work.
