<sup>10</sup> **All of your works will thank you, LORD, and your faithful followers will praise you.**  
<sup>11</sup> They will speak of the glory of your kingdom; they will give examples of your power.  
<sup>12</sup> **They will tell about your mighty deeds and about the majesty and glory of your reign.**  
<sup>13</sup> For your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. You rule throughout all generations.  
The LORD always keeps his promises; he is gracious in all he does. <sup>(b)</sup>  
<sup>14</sup> **The LORD helps the fallen and lifts those bent beneath their loads.**  
<sup>15</sup> The eyes of all look to you in hope; you give them their food as they need it.  
<sup>16</sup> **When you open your hand, you satisfy the hunger and thirst of every living thing.**  
<sup>17</sup> The LORD is righteous in everything he does; he is filled with kindness.  
<sup>18</sup> **The LORD is close to all who call on him, yes, to all who call on him in truth.**
