**Indonesia Territory**

### **Prayer Requests:**

1. The ongoing implementation of the Children's Home Review. Early this year the Cabinet approved most of the 50 recommendations made by the Review Committee. However the implementation of the changes is proving to be an onerous task. Over the next 5 years we will close a number of our Children's Homes and seek to upgrade others. Also we are updating and introducing many new policies to improve the standard and efficiency of our ministry with children.
2. The health of the officers in Indonesia. This is an ongoing concern (e.g. In 2017, 5 Officers have been Promoted to Glory) and we have been considering ways that we can assist our Officers (e.g. Medical check-ups when they have 5 and 15 year reviews.)
3. Pray that there is integrity and accountability throughout The Salvation Army. There is much corruption throughout the nation and unfortunately, this sometimes filters into the organization.
4. Please pray for the Training College cadets and staff (over 50 cadets) as they work towards passing government accreditation and implementing tertiary qualified training.
5. Pray for our education services as we continue to work with IHQ and SAWSO to provide teacher training and other resources and enhance this vital area of ministry for nearly 100 Salvation Army schools in Indonesia.

### **Praise Points:**

1. For the safe arrival of our new project officers, Envoys Kevin and Jane Sandford from the United Kingdom and Ireland Territory. Their visas were finally approved in late September, a process that took nearly five months.
2. For the employment of a Director for Education. This is a position that has been funded by SAWSO and will assist in the oversight of our 97 schools and training and upskilling of our teacher.
3. For the success of activities initiated by the "Whole World Mobilizing" campaign of 2017. This included free medical check-ups by hospitals and clinics, distribution of food and drinks at bus stations during Idul Fitre holidays.
4. Child Protection Training throughout the Territory. This project has been sponsored by the Australia Eastern Territory.
