The Caribbean Territory

Commissioners Devon & Verona Houghton & Chief Secretary Lt. Colonel Paul Main provide leadership in the Caribbean Territory of The Salvation Army, where the Army has been since 1887.



- 2019 marks the first time in its 131 year history that Jamaicans are leaders in this Territory.
- The Caribbean Territory has 248 active officers, 15 cadets, 998 employees, 130 corps, 45 outposts, 11, 812 senior soldiers, 2122 Adherents & 3743 junior soldiers.
- Last year, 8 new officers were commissioned, and this year, 15 cadets will take on their first appointments.
- Several regions in the Territory have been affected by this year's hurricane season and have received assistance. Recovery is ongoing in Antigua, Bahamas, Barbuda, St. Martin & Turks and Caicos.
