Commissioners Hans & Marja van Vliet & Chief Secretary Colonel Henrik Anderson provide leadership in the Netherlands & Czech Republic & Slovakia Territory of The Salvation Army.

- There are 120 active officers, 15 cadets, 63 corps, 11 outposts, 169 Institutions, 3694 senior soldiers, 1249 Adherents & 357 junior soldiers represented by this Territory. In Slovakia, where the work began in September 2015, there are 4 officers, 4 cadets, 1 envoy, 2 employees, and 13 senior soldiers. The main ministry here is for Roma people who suffer from poverty, abuse, addiction & prostitution.
- Last year's commissioning weekend welcome 8 newly commissioned lieutenants, the highest number in recent years. This year, 15 cadets anticipate being commissioned.
- A new endeavor is Scouting in the Netherlands, with a concentration on groups in multicultural and socially deprived districts.
- To address different needs, the Army operates ReShare, a recycling company. There are plans to open 20+ high quality second hand stores over 3 years, in all 3 regions. This gives jobs to the designers of the stores, volunteer positions for working there, and recycling of goods to help the communities at large.
- The Army in this territory has responded well to a great need for homeless supports, mother and child supports, life skills training and a farm project.

Please pray:

- for the leadership transition both in the Netherlands and in Czech and Slovakia this summer. Please pray for the people involved and for a smooth continuation of the work.
- that we might have resources for the work in Slovakia as new opportunities are developing.
- for wisdom and boldness as we explore starting new faith communities through existing social work expressions.
- for new officers and new corps members: adherents, soldiers and young soldiers.
- for the youth work as we are exploring new avenues of ministry.
