
International

The Army's work in India North was begun by Booth Tucker in 1882. With THQ in Delhi, the Army works in 10 different languages: *Bengali, English, Hindi, Kui, Nepali, Oriya, Punjabi, Santhali, Tamil, & Urdu.*

6) There are **legal issues related to property matters** so that they would come to a closure without further spending our funds for resolving those issues.

7) Prayer for **health concerns both active and retired officers** throughout the territory to live long and serve longer to the community.
