Glorious in his faithfulness.

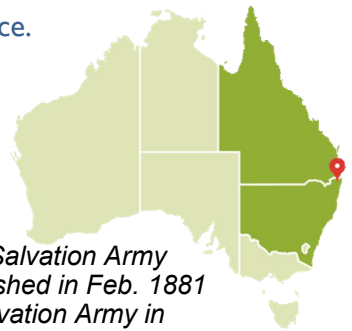
Verse 3

November 23, 2017—Australia Eastern Territory**



Two Christian Mission converts, John Gore and Edward Saunders, pioneered Salvation Army operations in September 1880 in Adelaide, with the work being officially established in Feb. 1881 with the appointment of Captain and Mrs Thomas Sutherland. In 1921, The Salvation Army in Australia was organized into Eastern and Southern Territories, with THQ for Eastern being set up in Sydney. The gospel is preached in Cantonese, English, Korean, Mandarin.
