
WORLD WIDE PRAYER MEETING November 30, 2017—Ghana Territory (includes Ghana & Togo)

Territorial Personnel & Ministries: There are 217 Active Officers, 55 Retired Officers, 15 Cadets, 1,697 Employees, 20,330 soldiers, 78 Adherents, 4,627 Junior Soldiers, 115 Corps, 144 Outposts, 234 Schools and 27 Health Centres and Clinics, plus a number of Social Work Centres: Vocational Training, Rehabilitation, Child Care, and Counselling. The Community Development Projects include Cerebral Palsy Centre, Urban Health Aid Centre, Physiotherapy Gym and Sponsorship Programs.

Territorial History & Mission: In 1922, Lieut. King Hudson was commissioned to 'open fire' in his home town of Duakwa, and later Ensign and Mrs. Charles Roberts were appointed to pioneer work in Accra. Work in neighbouring Togo was officially recognized on 1 April 2011.

The mission of The Salvation Army in Ghana is "to seek ways to introduce people to the gospel of Jesus Christ. Our teaching must strengthen them in their faith and understanding of the one true God, facilitating the growth of the Christian church. Our outreach is aimed at seeking and meeting the needs of the local community with initiative and vision as servants of Christ." Toward this aim, the gospel is preached in 11 different languages.

The Army of the Ghana Territory has asked us to pray:

- that many Christians in the Army in Ghana will respond to the call of the Lord into officership.
- that the spiritual life of both Officers and comrades will deepen in order for a Spirit-filled Army of the Lord be expanded by way of evangelism.
- That God will give higher wisdom to our Divisional Leaders, Officers and Local Leaders with regard to finances. We need strategic ideas to help our territory to be financially independent and stable.
- that youth, men and women will give their lives to God and respond to the call of officership without looking to what will happen to their lives in terms of finance.
- for Ghana as a nation—that God may continue to shower His peace upon the nation and grant leaders and rulers the wisdom and love for mankind
