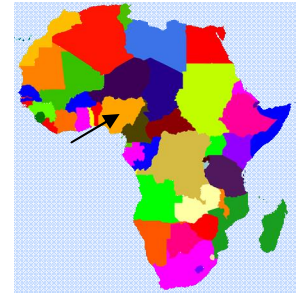




WORLD WIDE PRAYER MEETING
