

WORLD WIDE PRAYER MEETING January 19, 2017 The Netherlands & Czech Republic & Slovakia Territory

Commissioners Hans & Marja van Vliet & Chief Secretary Colonel Henrik Anderson provide leadership in the Netherlands & Czech Republic & Slovakia Territory of The Salvation Army.

- The Netherlands has 118 active officers, 22 cadets, 63 corps, 13 outposts, 169 Institutions, and 5,479 senior & junior soldiers and adherents.
- The Czech Republic has 18 active officers, 5 cadets, 2 envoys and 723 employees.
- There are over 700 hostel beds, a home for mothers and children, care for handicapped and homeless elderly people, life skills training and a farm project.
- Salvation Army work began in Slovakia in September 2015, making it the 127th country where the Army has a recognized legal presence. There are 4 officers, 4 cadets, I envoy, 2 employees, and 13 senior soldiers.
- The ministry in Slovakia is mainly to Roma people who suffer from poverty, abuse, addiction & prostitution.
