


How religious are Canadians?

Religion: where would you locate yourself?






How religious are Canadians?

42%







How positive, neutral, or negative do you tend to feel toward the following groups?




Thinking about your own municipal govt's council meetings, how do you feel about each of the following occurring at the beginning?

Summary of "Acceptable"







Private prayer in 2016


Thinking back over the last year, how often, if at all, have you:





Most pray, at least a little






- At least one prayer activity, once per week

1-in-5 pray every day


Thinking back over the last year, how often, if at all, have you prayed privately, individually?





And childhood prayer is important


Thinking back over the last year, how often, if at all, have you, prayed privately, individually:


When you pray privately, how often do you pray (those saying "often" or "sometimes" shown):


When you pray, do you mainly say prayers you have memorized, or mainly have a personal conversation with God or an object of worship?





Why Canadians pray


Which of the following are the three most important purposes of prayer in your life:





The experience of prayer ... the more you do it, the more it works


When you pray, how often do you experience the following:





Are prayers answered?


Do you feel your prayers are answered?

Do you feel your prayers are answered?






But what if God doesn't answer?

(Among all who pray)






Does prayer add value to life?

When all's said and done, do you think prayer ...


(All respondents, those who pray and those who do not)





Even 'rejecters' see value in prayer at an individual level


When all's said and done, do you think prayer adds something to the lives of people who pray?






But less value on a broader scale
