

## Host during fall harvest or close to Halloween!

**Set-up:** Include plenty of orange and pumpkins! Start with using orange tablecloths (plastic or check out clearance bins at your local fabric store. Use orange plates, cups and napkins. For the centerpiece use decorated pumpkins. You could place orange sequence around one and attach with straight pins, decorate another with gold thumb tacks, and a third use gold house numbers that can be purchased at dollar store. Add some splash to the table by adding some orange roses. For more decorations you could string orange pom-poms on long pieces of thread and hang over tables or around the room. For added detail add candles and mini pumpkin decorations to the table as well.

**Dinner:** Some suggestions of "orange" food that you could serve include:

- -orange cauliflower
- -buttered chicken and rice (add a few drops of red and yellow food coloring to make orange rice)
- -naan bread (use cookie cutter to make it pumpkin shaped)

or

- -macaroni & cheese
- -spaghetti
- -pizza

And for dessert serve pumpkin pie with whipped cream.
